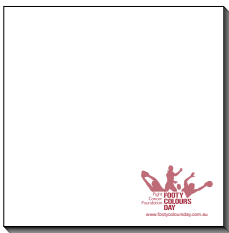

Why get involved?

More than 800 Australian children are diagnosed with cancer each year, often requiring long recovery periods as a result of treatments such as radiotherapy, chemotherapy or a bone marrow transplant. Recovering from a transplant can mean up to three years away from school. Imagine how far behind young people are in their schooling and social development as a result.



The *Back on Track* program was developed to assist children living with cancer - working with the patient's school, teachers, peers and medical staff to provide tailored tutoring programs for each child. Using technology such as the internet and virtual class room settings, *Back on Track* enables students to stay connected and helps avoid the isolation long absences from school can cause.

Not only does the *Back on Track* program provide learning and companionship, it gives children with cancer the opportunity to reach their full potential.
