Biography Youla CHAPOVAL

1919 - 1951

1919 - Born of Youla Chapoval in Kiev (Russia)

1924 - His family moved to Paris

1938 - Baccalauréat and meeting of Picasso

1939 - Begins study of medicine with his friend Victor Smirnoff. Frequent at the same time La Grande Chaumière

1940-41 - Chantiers de jeunesse. Abandon the medicine to dedicate itself to the painting Got acquainted with Maurice Sachs and with Jean Cocteau

1942 - Flees Paris after the raid of Vélodrome d'hiver. His mother and one of her sisters are deported. Live in Marseille, where he follows some lessons at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts. Meet Roger Van Gindertael who, till the end will be an attentive adviser.

1943 - Live in Toulouse where he studies at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts. Back to Paris he meets Jeanne Despujols, his future wife, and leave in Montmartre.

1944 - He learn the death of his mother and his sister in deportation. Visit Picasso where he meet James Lord. live in a pension hold by Jeanne Despujols in front of Cluny museum. Back to la Grande Chaumière.

1946 - wedding Jeanne Despujols. Move in 43 avenue Montaigne. Meet the artdealer Henri Bénézit who buy his first paintings and will go on. Pierre Berès buy also paintings.

1947- New visit by Picasso where he meets Douglas Cooper. Henri Benezit introduce him to the collector Roger Dutilleul, beginning of a long friendship.
2nd Price of the young painting
Exhibition at the galerie Jeanne Bucher.

1948- Collective Exhibition at the galerie Jeanne Bucher.

1949- Death of his father. Start Abstraction.

The Art critic Charles Estienne move in with him.

Exhibition at the galerie Jeanne Bucher. Participe at the collective exhibition de groupe «Les mains éblouies» at galerie Maeght.

Price Kandinsky with Marie Raymond.

L'Etat lui achète une oeuvre «La Houille»

1950- Exhibition of Marie Raymond and Chapoval at galerie Denise René. Exhibition «Les prix Kandinsky» at galerie Denise René. Participe to Salon de Mai and «Réalités Nouvelles».

1951 - Participe to Salon de Mai; the collector Graindorge bought there a work. Participe at Salon des Réalités Nouvelles. Move in to Montmartre. Back to Figuration
